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Budget Policies

 Administrative and Management Service Agreement Policy 100.2 – SGA shares 50% of the administrative costs incurred by RWA to run both organizations

3.4 Full Time Employees for SGA:

50% - Executive Director, Manager of Technical Services, FASM, & Exec. Assistant (2 FTE)

 20% - Project Research Assistant, Manager of Government Relations (.4 FTE)

100% - Senior Project Manager (1 FTE)

 Compensation Policy 100.3 - salaries within range plus potential for COLA and merit for eligible staff





Budget Policies – cont'd.

- Reserve Policy 400.2 goal is to have a minimum of 4 months and a maximum of 6 months to fund operating expenses.
- Budget Policy 400.3 approve a budget prior to July 1st
- JPA Double Majority Vote to approve budget (Member Vote/Weighted Financial Contribution Vote)
- Defined Benefit Pension Plan Funding Policy 400.4 accelerated funding of unfunded pension plan over four years
 - SGA has their own PERS account
 - SGA Unfunded Accrued Liability (UAL) is \$241,305
 - SGA additional UAL pension contribution of \$60,400
 - Employee's pay their full share





Fees Calculation Methodology

- Fees two components: Base & Groundwater
- Base Fee (Retail Connections)
 - 0 6,000 connections = FY 24/25 \$12,562
 - Connections over 6,000 = FY 24/25 \$1.63 per connection
- Groundwater Fee (5-year avg of groundwater pumped within SGA boundaries)
 - FY 24/25 \$7.74 per acre foot
- Historical Target
 - Base Fee 42%
 - Groundwater Fee 58%





FY 2024/25 Budget Assumptions

When FY 24/25 Budget was approved, SGA assumed:

- GSP Implementation offset by SGMA Grant
- Grant Staff Time Reimbursement of \$162k
- Additional CalPERS funding of \$52k
- 0% fee increase in FY 25/26 and FY 26/27





FY 2024/25 Budget Outlook

 FY 24/25 budget had a planned deficit of \$12k covered by SGA reserves

 FY 24/25 had a 3% Base Fee and 9% Groundwater
Fee increase, which resulted in a total fee increase of 2.88%

FY 2025/26 Budget Outlook

 SGMA Grant (DWR) – SGA will continue to benefit from the grant covering some GSP Implementation expenses and by receiving reimbursement for staff time spent working on the grant.

 GSP Implementation – SGA expenses will increase due to the SGMA Grant coming to an end.

As with any budget, numbers are based on estimates.
Actual budget results may not be achieved.





Budget Schedule

- Chair typically appoints a Budget Subcommittee in February
- Subcommittee meets one or two times
- Budget approval at SGA's April Board Meeting
- If Budget is not approved, Budget Subcommittee meets again to revise budget for SGA's June Board Meeting
